

Scholarship Guidelines

Aidea Design Foundation

Benefits

Successful recipients will be awarded with 100% coverage of their tuition and miscellaneous fees, a monthly allowance, plus a chance to attend supplemental formation, training and workshops sponsored by Aidea Inc.

Qualifications of Applicants

The Aidea Design Foundation Scholarship application is open to all students who will pass the following criteria:

1. A Filipino citizen and an incoming Junior or Third Year students of Architecture, Interior Design, Landscape Architecture and Computer Programming enrolled in any government recognized colleges or universities in the Philippines.
2. With excellent grades and outstanding general weighted average (GWA) from 1st year to current year of application.
3. Without failing or incomplete grade in any subject.
4. With total annual household (*combination of all working family members*) income not exceeding Php 500,000.
5. Not concurrently recipient of any major scholarship or financial aid (e.g. pre-need educational plans, DOST or other academic-related scholarship etc.).

Mechanics and Selection Process

1. Applicant must accomplish the Aidea Design Foundation, Inc. Scholarship Application Form and submit supporting documents for initial screening.

1.1 Supporting documents are as follows:

- a. Transcript of Records or True Copy of Grades from the College Secretary or University Registrar or its equivalent office (First year to Second year/current year).
- b. Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate.
- c. Latest Income Tax Return (2016) of all working household members or Certificate of Tax Exemptions from the employer/BIR.
- d. At least two (2) Recommendation Letters from Professors/Dean and Certificate of Good Moral Character from College Secretary or its equivalent office.

3. Aidea Design Foundation, Inc. will pre-screen the applicants and scholars will be selected based on the following:
 - a. Paper evaluation of application form and credentials
 - b. Interview
4. Pre-qualified applicants shall be invited for an initial interview and those who will pass shall be invited for the final interview with the committee.
5. Successful scholarship recipients will be notified by the Foundation coordinator thru E-mail and Text message.
